COURSE OFFERED & DURATION

The Institute offers Three Year Diploma in General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM). This is 3 (three) years full time Boarding Course and internship is of six months (26 weeks). There will be a probation period of three months (13 weeks), during which the students will be introduced to basic sciences - Physics, Chemistry and Biology. An examination will be held at the end of three months to assess the student's ability to enter the professional nursing course.

ELIGIBILITY

- Candidates who have passed H.S. (Science/Arts) preferably in Science Stream (PCB) & English with aggregate of 40% marks from any recognized Board.
- Candidates who have passed ANM Examination and registered with any State Nursing Registration Council.
- Aged not less than 17 years and not more than 35 years at the time of admission.



ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission Form & prospectus can be obtained in person from the College Office on payment of Rs.500/-. Alternatively students can also apply online at https://www.nefnursing.org. Admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit.



INFRASTRUCTURE

CLASSROOM FACILITIES:

The Institute comprises of spacious and well ventilated rooms with modern infrastructure. The institute has provided spacious class rooms in a peaceful environment with comfortable seating arrangement and is well equipped with LCD projectors, whiteboards, Wi-Fi-enabled systems making the classroom learning process an engaging and unique experience for all.

The Institute has a Digital Classroom with interactive panel for better experience with improved online teaching-learning interaction. The Digital classroom is also used to organise online guest lectures which helps the students to interact with experts from all over the world in real time to gather knowledge and clarify their doubts.

LIBRARY FACILITES:

The Institute has a spacious and well-furnished automated library that contains more than 3,000 books on Nursing and Health Sciences. It has a facility of book bank system. Library provides 10 journals / periodicals and 9 dailies of various languages. Besides these, the library provides internet facility also. The library remains open on all days except Sundays and holidays.

NOTE

- (1) In addition to above fees, students are required to pay Nursing Council / University Registration Fee, Examination Fee etc as and when required.

SPECIFIC RULES FOR STUDENT DISCIPLINE

- Students are required to wear prescribed uniform while attending classes, laboratories and in the hospital during clinical training.

- During clinical training, students are required to maintain punctuality, discipline and follow the rules and regulations of the Hospital Authority.
- Students shall avoid using any insulting, inciting, threatening language when talking with fellow students and should abstain themselves from violence.
- Students shall not talk or act in any manner outside the institution in a way that would bring disrepute to the Institute.
- The students shall be regular and punctual in attending classes and all activities connected with the Institute.
- Gathering in groups at road, entrance, exit and pathways is strictly prohibited.
- The students shall observe strict silence in the class irrespective of the presence or absence of the faculty member.
- The campus is a no-tobacco zone. Consumption of any tobacco product is strictly banned inside the campus.
